HOW TO GET THERE

Novara is easily reachable from any part of Europe since it is near and well connected to three main international airports. The best choice to reach Novara is to land at Milan Malpensa international airport (IATA: MXP) and then take the BUS to Novara. Milan Malpensa is a big hub for easyjets flights. Milan Malpensa Bus to Novara ends very close both to the course venue and the Hotel. Here you can find the bus timetable: <http://www.stnnet.it/novaramalpensa.html> you have to get off at Novara Autostazione.

Other airports landing in Milan are Milano Linate (IATA: LIN) and Milano Bergamo (IATA: BGY). The latter is the farthest from Milano and it will take approximately one hour bus ride to get to central Milano. Ryanair flies to Bergamo.

If you arrive in Milano by Train it is very easy to reach Novara from Milano Centrale station or Milano Garibaldi station. There are frequent trains every hour. The ride takes approximately 45 minutes.
